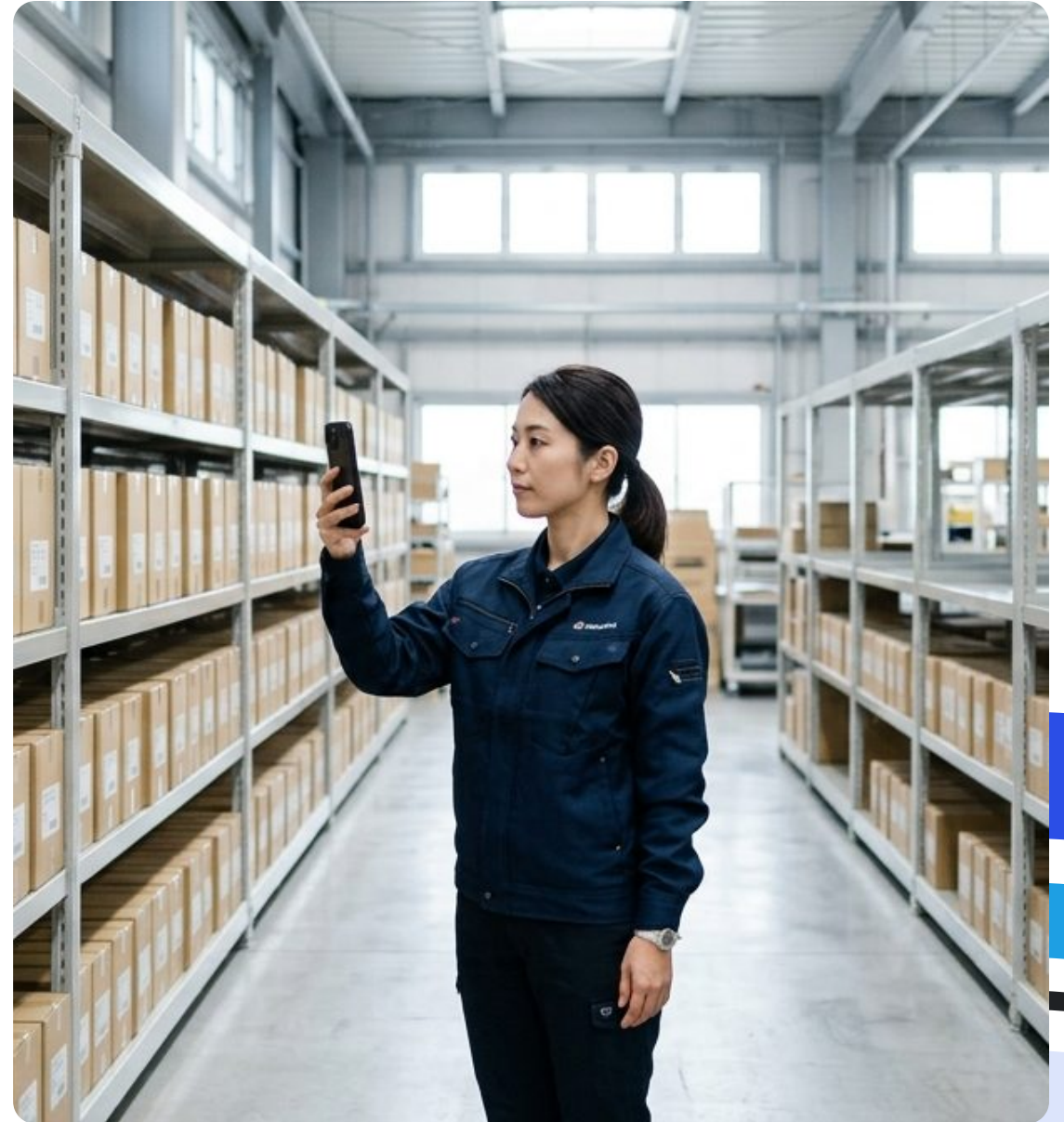

Stock counts in 5 min.

Introducing Stella, automated inventory counting



Two hours every morning, lost to counting

Problem

Staff count by hand, copy it into Excel, and recount whole shelves when numbers don't match. With too few people, **two hours every morning** go to counting.



From the floor

If the numbers are off, we miss the morning meeting

Any mismatch means recounting the whole shelf. Reports don't arrive until noon, so ordering decisions slip a day.

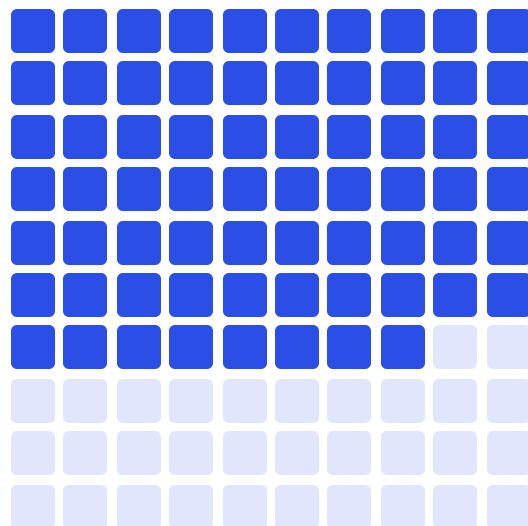

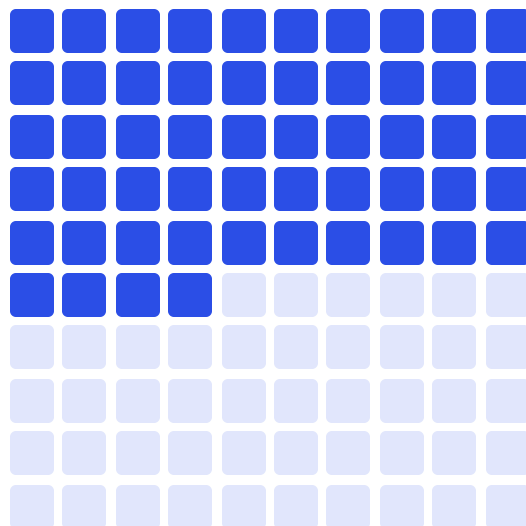

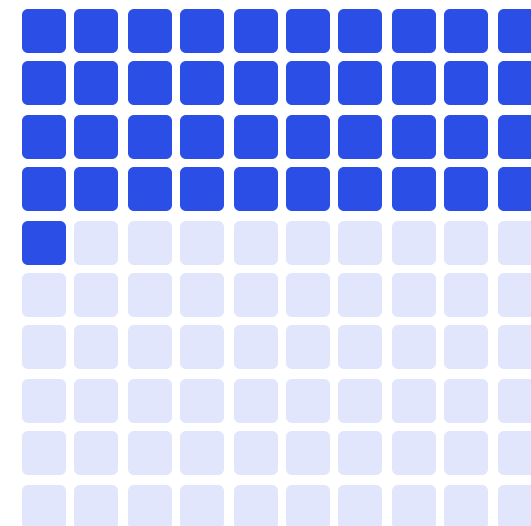

Scan the shelf tag, and **stock is settled**

Overview

Scan a shelf tag with a phone and the count is settled on the spot
Because you **only check what changed** since yesterday, the morning count takes 5 minutes.



How it works

Scan, compare, report

Scanning a tag settles the count. Stella flags only the shelves that differ from yesterday, and the checked results reach everyone at 8 a.m.

No special device. Works on the phones you have

Scan tags with a phone

No special device. Scan with the phone you have and the count is settled

Compares with yesterday and sorts out why (late deliveries, missed scans)

Report every morning at 8

Everyone sees the same numbers before the meeting

COMPARE · FEATURE 04

Trends by site

See differences and trends on one screen

CONNECT · FEATURE 05

Works with ordering and delivery

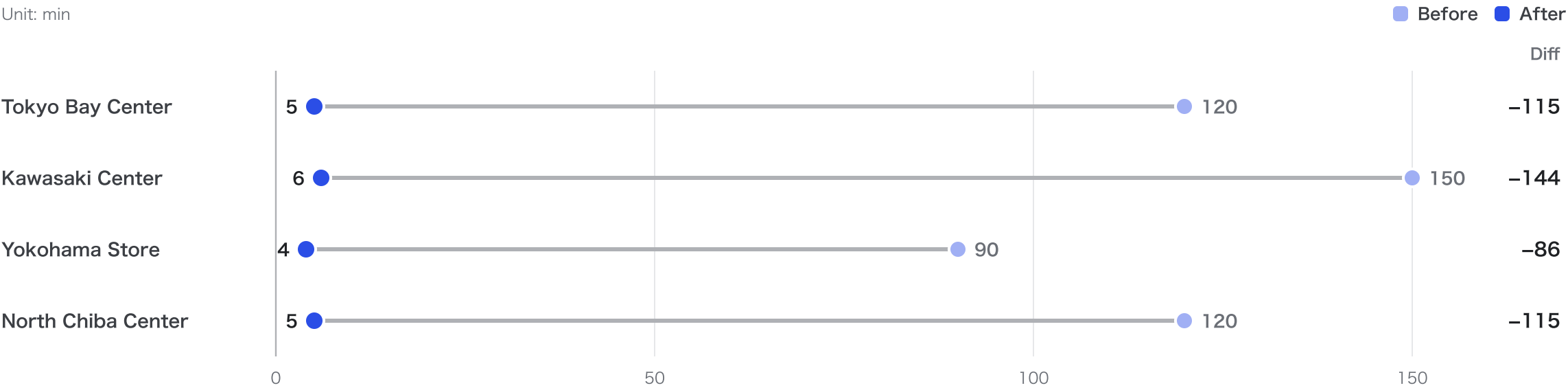
Order quantities and delivery routes update right away

Our proposal

Start with one site. Compare it with your current count during a 30-day free trial.

Counting time cut to 1/24 at 4 pilot sites

Minutes per morning count at one site (the month before rollout vs. three months after)



Outcome

With the same team, one site got 1,440 hours a year back for receiving.

* 4 pilot sites (April–September 2025). Average went from 120 to 5 minutes. Company names, people and numbers are fictional.

Minato Logistics: morning counts from 2 hours to 5 minutes

Problem

Four people counted shelves from 6 a.m., recounting whole shelves on any mismatch. **Some days they missed the morning meeting.**

120 → 5 min

Every morning's count
4 people → 1 person checking



What they did

Rolled out to 6 centers in 3 weeks

Our operations team handled tagging and the pilot. They set the rules for differences at one site, then expanded to the other five.

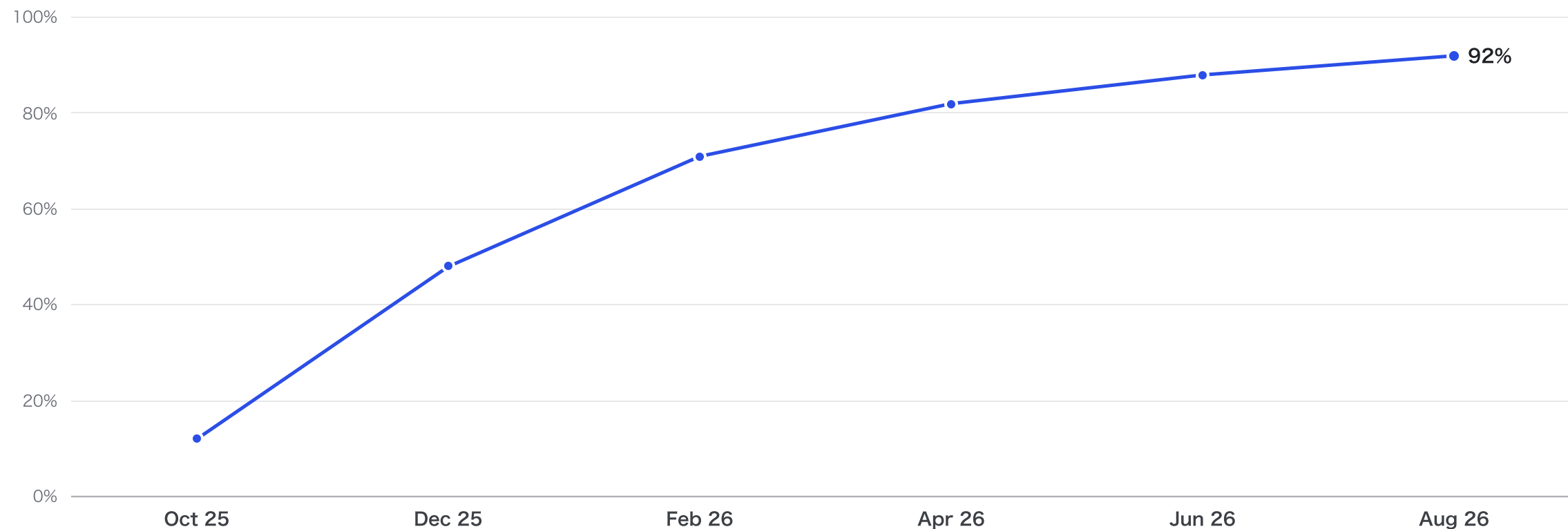

Sakura Mart: 9 in 10 days now have zero mismatches

Share of days with no stock mismatches across all 38 stores (by month)



Outcome

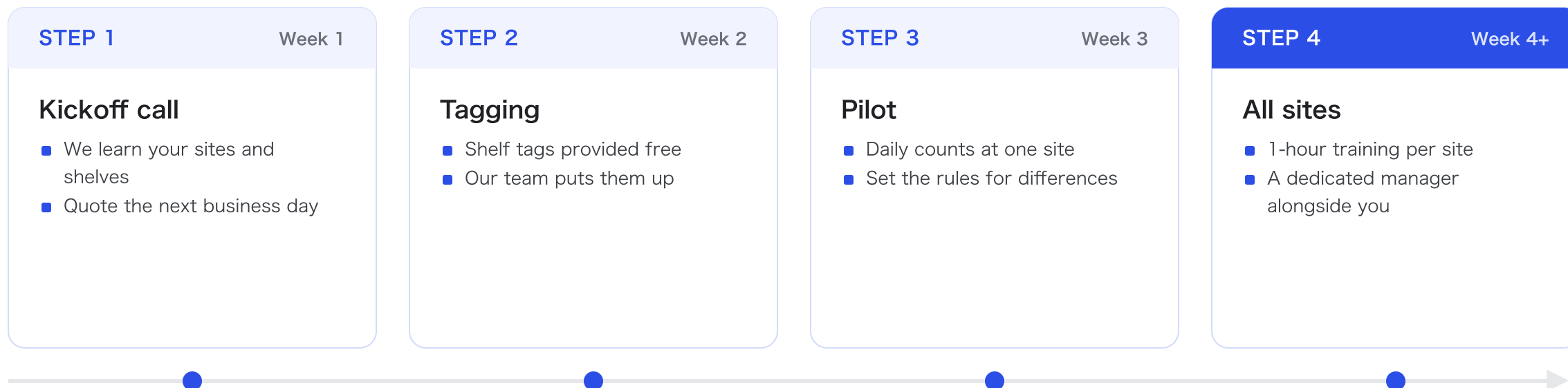
Zero-mismatch days went from 12% to 92%, saving 38 hours of counting per store each month.
